about the kingdom of heaven.

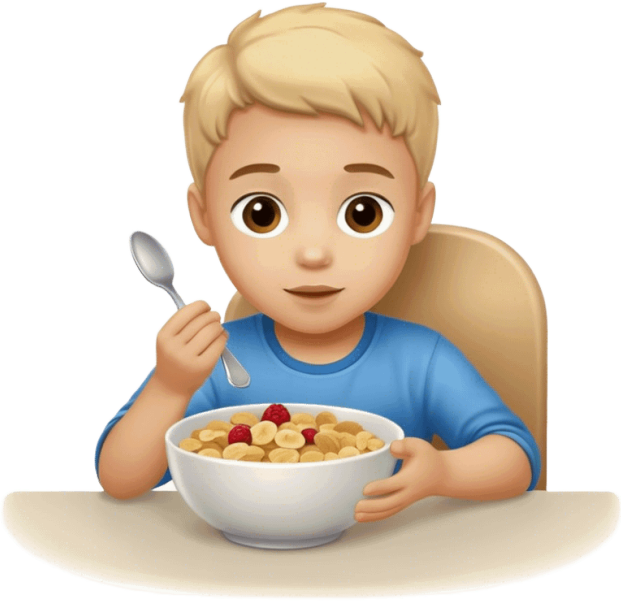
God the Holy Spirit

Amen.

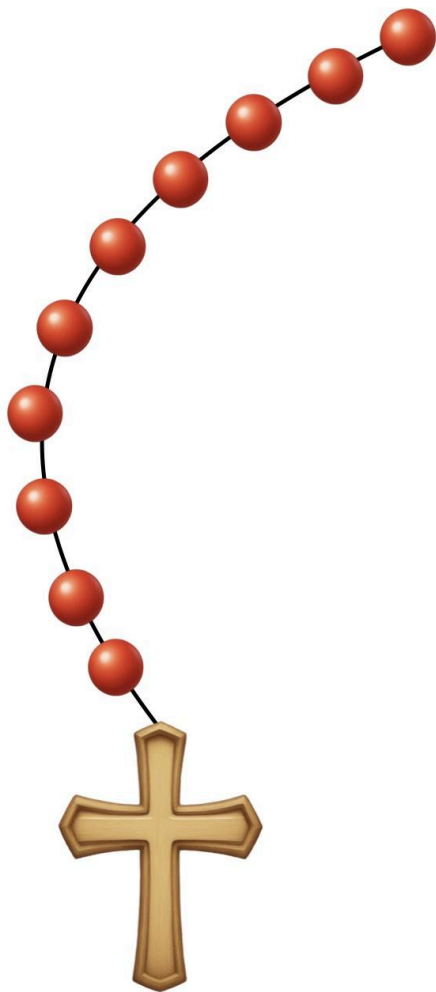


Hail Mary
